FPS Announces May 2025 Sinking Fund Renewal

In May 2025, Fremont Public Schools will seek community support for the renewal of our sinking fund. The renewal will help us make critical improvements and upgrades to our campus facilities.

This fall, FPS contracted renowned architectural engineering firm Kingscott Associates to conduct a site assessment to identify areas of greatest need. In the new year, they will share their recommendations and design mockups of proposed new construction facilities.

Operational improvements were highlighted as one of the highest priorities in our district's Strategic Plan, and renewing the sinking fund is a key first-year objective toward addressing those needs. It's important to note that this renewal will not raise millage rates. Instead, it will maintain the existing rate, allowing us to continue our work in a steady, sustainable way to support school maintenance and growth.
