- Fremont ASP provides after school care for grades K-8 on days that FPS has full days of school until 6:00 p.m. Half day care will be offered when we can get a minimum of 15 students pre-registered for each half day.
- ASP programs are located in each building so no worries about your child having to move between buildings.
- ASP programs provide a daily snack, physical activity, homework help, disguised learning to support school day program and free play time.
- ASP is a tuition-based program with reduced rates available for families whose income qualify them for free or reduced lunch.

READY TO ENROLL?

- Complete the enclosed enrollment forms (ASP Enrollment form and Child Information Record). If you are enrolling more than one child, each child needs their own enrollment form and child information record card.
- To qualify for scholarship, you must submit the Education Benefits Form to the FPS Nutrition Services Department. Only one is needed per family and if you already filled it out with your child's school office you do not need to complete it again. Education Benefits Forms for the 2024-2025 school will not be available until Fall of 2024.
